
The 5 Underrecognized ECG in ACS

1. **Left main occlusion or TVD**

- STE in aVR &/or
- Widespread STD

1. **D1 LAD occlusion**

- STE in aVL and V2
- Upright T in aVL and V2
- STD and inverted T in III and aVF

1. **Posterior wall MI**

- Horizontal (flat) STD in V1-V3
- Prominent R in V1-V2
- Upright T in V1- V3

4. **Wellens' syndrome**

- Biphasic T in V1-V4 (type A or II) or
- Deep inverted T in V1-V4 (type B or I)

5. **De Winter's T**

- Upsloping STD at J Point in V1-V4 without STE
- Tall symmetric T in V1- V4
- STE in aVR +/- aVL
