

COVID-19 test centre

If you need to be tested for COVID-19 and do not have any symptoms, you can go to the COVID-19 test centre of UZ Gent. Care providers carry out 240 tests each day.

Who can get tested?

You have **no symptoms** of COVID-19 and:

- you need to go to UZ Gent for an **operation, day admission, or admission for several days**.
- you had a **high-risk contact** with an infected person.
- you need the test before a **trip** and all of your travel vaccinations are in order. If you are unsure whether you need vaccinations, make an [appointment with the Travel Clinic](#) as soon as possible.
- you completed the [Passenger Locator Form](#) upon your **return from abroad** and were informed that you need to be tested.
- you must be tested as part of a **cluster study** or in a COVID-19 outbreak in a school, business, or other community.

If you experience symptoms that may indicate you have COVID-19, please contact your GP. Anyone needing urgent help can be tested at the Emergency Department.

Make an appointment

- If you need to go to UZ Gent for an operation or admission, you can make the appointment by contacting the **administrative office of the department providing you with treatment**.
- In other cases, you make the appointment via your **GP** or the **appointment portal** at mijn.uzgent.be.
- You may also drop by without an appointment.

Price

Health insurance covers all costs unless:

- you need the test to go abroad
- the test does not meet [Sciensano's criteria](#)

Test result

You can find the result of the test **within 24 hours** in your online medical file at www.cozo.be. Your family doctor can also access this file. If you test positive, you will be notified by phone.

We recommend that travellers take the test 48 hours before departure. This ensures you will have the test result on time.

Location

The COVID-19 test centre is located next to the GP out-of-hours post at entrance 26E, route 2626. The centre can be reached by phone at 09 332 12 30.

Opening times

- Every **weekday** from **8 am to 6 pm**
- On **Saturday** from **8 am to 12 noon**

The test centre collaborates with Gent First-Line Care and Scheldekracht First-Line Care.
